O R D E R :

Section 95 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 (Central Act No.6 of 2014) provides that the existing admission quotas in all Government or private, aided or unaided, institutions of higher, technical and medical education in so far as it is provided under article 371-D of the Constitution, shall continue as such for a period of ten years during which the existing common admission process shall continue.

2. On expiry of the period of ten years provided in section 95 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act 2014, the Government, after careful examination of the matter, have decided to amend the Telangana Medical and Dental Colleges Admissions (Admissions into Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery & Bachelor of Dental Surgery Courses) Rules, 2017 issued in G.O. 2<sup>nd</sup> read above and as subsequently amended from time to time vide references 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> read above.
3. Accordingly the following notification shall be published in the Telangana Gazette, Dated: 22 /07/2024.

N O T I F I C A T I O N

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act 1983 (Act No.5 of 1983), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following amendments to the Telangana Medical and Dental Colleges Admissions (Admissions into Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery & Bachelor of Dental Surgery Courses) Rules, 2017 issued vide G.O.Ms.No.114 HM&FW (C1) Department, dated 05.07.2017 and as subsequently amended from time to time.

AMENDMENT

In the said rules,

1. In rule 3 for sub-rule (a), the following shall be substituted namely:-

(a) A candidate for admission into undergraduate courses under 'Competent Authority Quota' in Telangana should be Indian National/ Person of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) card holder and shall fulfill the following provisions:

(P.T.O)

:: 2 ::

i) If the candidate has studied in educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.

or

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in any educational institutions, if he has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

iii) Local area herein means the State of Telangana. Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the local area as stated at (b) above, to be eligible for admission into undergraduate courses under 'Competent Authority Quota', the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana

(b) in sub-rule (II),

i) for clause (b) the following shall be substituted namely:-

"b) 10% of seats in each course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes".

ii) clause (d) and clause (e) shall be deleted.

(c) sub-rule (III) shall be deleted.

(d) in sub-rule (V), for clause (a) the following shall be substituted namely :-

"(a) The reservation for SC, ST and BCs shall be 15%, 10% and 29% respectively"

2. in rule 4, sub-rule (viii) and sub-rule (ix) shall be deleted.

3. in rule 5, sub-rule (v) shall be deleted.

To

(A) " The Local Areas " means

- (a) The part of the State comprising the Districts of Adilabad, Hyderabad (Including Twin Cities) Rangareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Medak, Mahaboobnagar, Nalgonda, Nizamabad and Warangal shall be regarded as the Osmania University Local Area (Telangana)
- (b) The part of the state comprising the District of Srikakulam Vizianagaram, Vishakapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the Andhra University Local area (Andhra)
- (c) The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, Cuddapah and Nellore shall be regarded as the Sri Venkateswara University Local Area (Rayalaseema):

(B) The Local Candidate: A candidate for admission shall be regarded as a local candidate in relation to a local area.

- a) If he has studied in educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less

than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.

OR

- (b) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in any educational Institutions, If he has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

(C) A Candidate for admission into the course who is not regarded as local candidate under clause (A) In relation, to any local area shall

- (i) If he has studied in Educational Institutions in the State for a period of not less than seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

- (a) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years.

OR

- (b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area, where he/she has studied last in such equal period.

OR

- (ii) If, during the whole or any part of seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination he/she has, not studied in the educational institutions in any local area but has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of seven years, be regarded as a local candidate in relation to

- (a) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years.

OR

- (b) Where the periods of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local areas Where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.

(D): The following categories of candidates are eligible to apply for admission to the remaining 15 % of un reserved seats

- (a) All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates.
- (b) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State.
- (c) Candidates who are the children of the parents who are in employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and Educational Institutions other similar quasi Public Institutions within the State.
- (d) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University Or other Competent Authority and similar quasi Government Institutions within the State.

(E) If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seat reserved or allocated in favour of a local candidate in respect of that local area such seat shall be filled as if it has been un-reserved, in the orders of ranking assigned in the Common Merit List,
