ORDER:

Whereas, in the reference 1st read above, Government issued orders for design, development and implementation of Integrated Land Records Management System (ILRMS) under the project Dharani and decided to issue Letter of Intent to M/s. IL&FS Technologies Limited (later M/s. TerraCIS), with a contract period of three (3) years from the date of Go-Live of the application and requested the Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, TG, Hyderabad to take the ownership of the project and constitute a Project Implementation Committee consisting of senior officials of Revenue Department with representatives of Information Technology Electronics & Communication Department and Telangana Technology Services (TGTS) Ltd. for close monitoring on the implementation of the project.

2. And whereas, in the reference 2nd read above, Government issued orders for constitution of Project Implementation Committee, drafting certain officers to interact regarding the domain issues related to phase wise services with the M/s. IL&FS Technologies Limited (later M/s. TerraCIS) and fixing up the roles and responsibilities for Revenue Department, Registration & Stamps Department, Information Technology Electronics & Communication Department and TGTS.

3. And whereas, in the reference 3rd read above, the Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, TG, Hyderabad has reported that, TGTS and IL&FS Technologies Ltd. (M/s. TerraCIS) have signed a Contract Agreement dated: 20.04.2018, and, Dharani portal is declared Go Live by the Government on dated: 29.10.2020 and Operations & Maintenance (O&M) phase of 3 years is started from Go-live date to till 29.10.2023.

4. And whereas, on recommendation of the Project Implementation Committee, extension order towards Operations & Maintenance and Support Services for (1) year period till 29.10.2024 was issued to M/s TerraCIS by the TGTS. Since the contract agreement is going to expire on 29.10.2024, the committee constituted in the reference 4th read above, has opined that the Dharani portal Operations & Maintenance shall be made with any one of the Government / Public agencies i.e., National Informatics Centre (NIC) or CGG or TG-Online.

5. And whereas, in the reference 5th read above, Government have constituted a committee to identify a suitable agency by following established procedures to continue the Operations & Maintenance of Dharani portal. The Committee, after thorough discussions, recommended to engage the services of National Informatics Centre (NIC), under the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Govt. of India for the Operations & Maintenance

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of Dharani Portal, as NIC has extensive experience in Land Record Management, with a contract period of (3) years initially & extendable by (2) years based on performance of the agency, and Transition period for (2) months i.e. from 30.09.2024 to 30.11.2024 with an extension of (1) month of the existing contract with M/s TerraCIS.

6. Government, after careful examination of the matter, hereby order to engage the services of National Informatics Centre (NIC), under the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Govt. of India for the Operations & Maintenance of Dharani Portal, with a contract period of (3) years initially & extendable by (2) years based on performance of the agency, and Transition period for (2) months till 30.11.2024 with an extension of (1) month of the existing contract with M/s TerraCIS.

7. The Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, TG, Hyderabad, the Information Technology Electronics & Communication Department and Telangana Technology Services (TGTS) Ltd. shall take necessary further action in the matter, accordingly.
